learning approach, including using the outdoors to support the development of the chidlren's independence and resilience.

Phonics & Early Reading


We will be completing daily structured Phonics learning following the Government accredited Twinkl Phonics scheme. New sounds will be introduced each day and then consolidated at the end of the week.



We will send home regular sheets to inform you of the sound we are working on that includes activities and tasks to help support learning at home.



Alongside this we will be engaging in daily activities to encourage all the children to further develop and extend their phonics skills, we will be exploring rhythm and rhyme, different sounds within the environment and using their bodies for movement and dance to help this learning 'stick'.



Class Dojo is both our main learning platform as well as our primary method for communication across the school. We use it daily to keep you informed about what your child is learning as well

as what and how they are doing through updates, photos and commentaries, which you, as parents, can comment and add to.

It is a quick and easy way to communicate with you all via group and individual messages. We hope you, like us, find it a useful tool to relay information quickly and efficiently.
