HUNDON: STAFFING AND CLASS ORGANISATION UPDATE ~ SEPTEMBER 2024

As the end of term looms and with our 'Move Up' days early next week we wanted to keep you informed of developments related to staffing and class organisation with the new academic year in mind.

You know we have been very clear in our desire for our four-class structure to continue and as a result have, again, focused on recruitment continuously through the year. Our Class Teacher arrangements will remain much as they are, allowing colleagues to further build and consolidate their excellent work this year with few changes.

We will be welcoming the soon to be Mrs Maisie Wiffen (currently Miss Maisie Giblenn) who many of you will remember has met lots of the children as part of her successful interview back in mid-May. As mentioned before Mrs Wiffen (to be) brings a wealth of key stage two experience and will be joining the Federation to lead our year 5 and 6's in Hawthorn Class here at Hundon. Mrs Wiffen will be with us next week for our 'Move Up' days so the children will have time to get properly acquainted.

This change will maintain the consistency in teaching for Hawthorn Class whilst affording the Federation additional leadership capacity by providing Miss Buckle, our Federation Deputy Headteacher a reduced teaching commitment.

Oak Class (Year 3/4) will continue to be led by Miss Blackwell and Willow Class (Year 1/2) will continue to be taught be Mrs Thompson. Mrs Copping will continue leading our new reception children in Cherry Class.

Additional learning support for specific individuals and groups of children will continue with our existing learning support team members as well as new colleagues (recruitment is on-going.)
