On the 28th November, Rebecca (in Hares Class, at our sister school,) is cutting 15 inches off her hair to donate to the **Little Princess Trust.** She is doing this in memory of Bryony Dearman, a parent in the Thurlow school family, who died a year ago after a battle with cancer.

The **Little Princess Trust** is a charity that provides real hair wigs, free of charge, to children and young people who have lost their own hair through cancer treatment or other conditions such as Alopecia. She is also fundraising to raise money towards paying for a wig to be made.

Rebecca is only 10 years old, and has been growing her hair since she was 2. In her words, "For most people our hair is a large part of our personality so it will be a major change for me to cut off 15" of my hair ~ especially as I have been growing it since I was 2 years old! I cannot imagine how lifechanging losing all your hair is and I am really pleased that my hair will be used to make a wig for a child that has."

DRIVING AND PARKING AROUND THE SCHOOL SITE

We are sending this message to remind parents and carers of the importance of driving and parking safely around the school site. Please consider leaving a little earlier and use the parking available at the village hall or the Rose and Crown and take the short walk to and from the school site.

Children remain the responsibility of their parents until they are handed over to school staff at the start of the school day. Please, please have due care and attention when dropping off and collecting your child/ren.
