SCHOOL MEALS ~ SPRING TERM 2024 ~ FIRST HALF

The cost of a school meal in Years 3 to 6 is £2.60 (a week is £13.00.) **School meals MUST be paid for in advance**. Payment is required online where a minimum of five meals must be purchased at any one time. The cost of the first half of the Spring term is £75.40. AN IMPORTANT REMINDER: ADDITIONAL SUPPORT AT THURLOW

Across our school, for various reasons and circumstances, or perhaps related to learning need, difficulty or challenge, there are individuals in receipt of additional input.

This input can take a variety of forms. It may include an individualised timetable, particular adaptations to the school day, a personalised plan as well as the use of specific programmes and various interventions linked to defined areas of learning such as social development, early reading, an aspect of Maths etc...

This additional support may include directed learning support, work with one of our ELSA's (Emotional Literacy Support Assistants,) one-to-one input as part of an intervention and small group work.

Additionally, the school supports families in making referrals for the identification of neurodevelopmental conditions and, where appropriate, applying for assessments for Education Health Care Plans (EHCPs) as well as supporting families to access external specialist services and support agencies including School Nursing, Family Support Services, Young Carers and Children's Social Care.

As parents or carers, you need to know this is available to children who may be in vulnerable or difficult circumstances and you need to know this work is currently taking place. As parents and carers, I am sure you can understand it would not be appropriate to share more information than this for reasons related to privacy and confidentiality ~ children and their parents and carers should not know private and personal information about another child or family and what is or isn't in place to support them just as it would not be right to share private and personal information relating to your child or circumstances.

I share this information as I want to ensure there are no misunderstandings about what is or isn't happening or is or isn't being done in school for individuals.

If there is anything that you feel we are not aware of related to your child or their class it is, of course, your child's Class Teacher you need to speak to in the first instance. The easiest and quickest way is via our learning platform, Class Dojo. Our teaching team is very conscientious and will endeavour to respond within working hours, that is between 8am and 6pm (at the latest,) Monday to Friday or on the next working day.

If any parent has concerns regarding additional support at Thurlow or any other matter then I encourage you to make an appointment to see me.
